

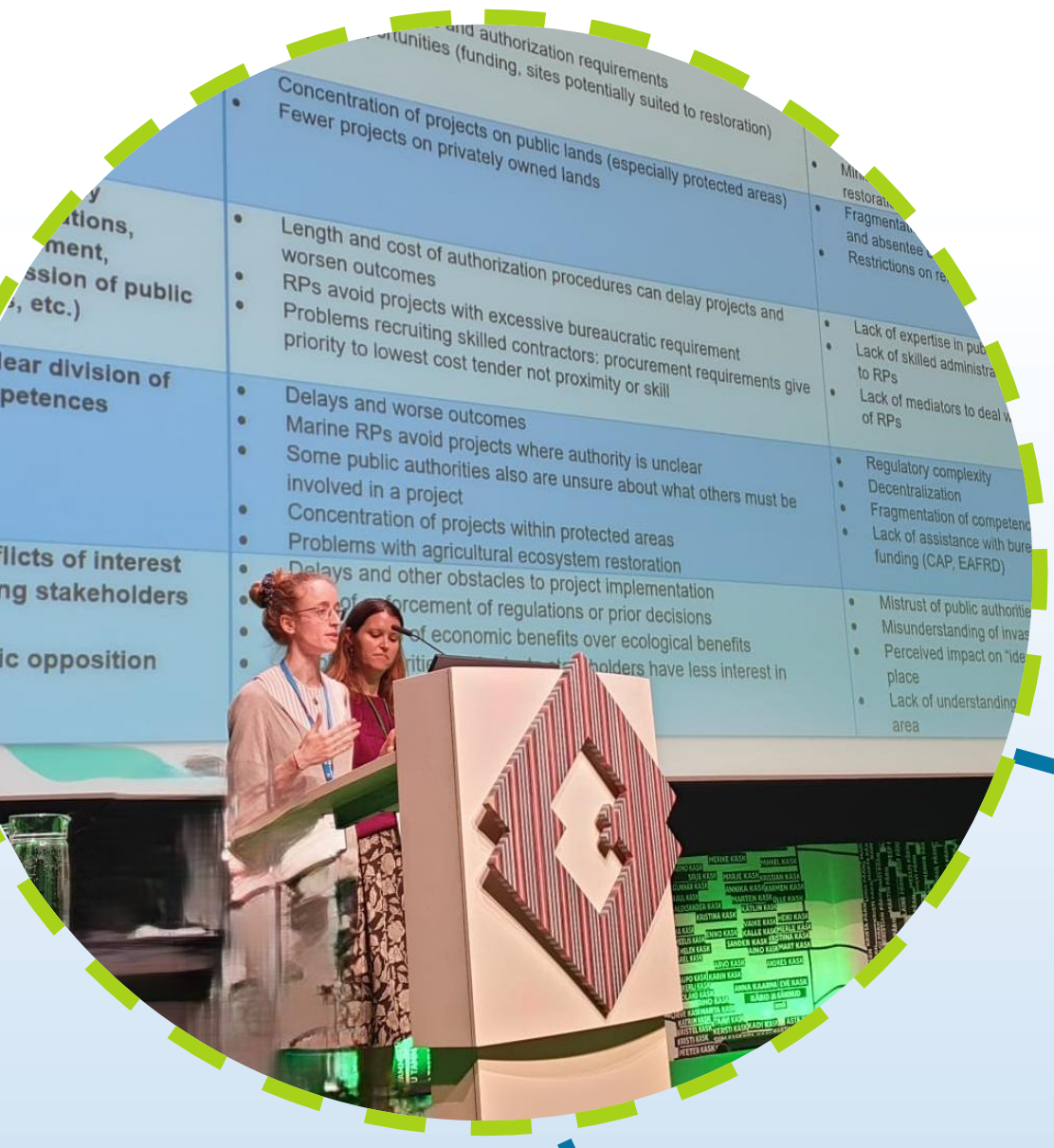

Objectives

- Promote biodiversity conservation and ecosystem restoration, understood as actions aimed at maintain or restoring to good status natural and semi-natural habitats in Italy;
- Promote the use of best practices and standards within current regional, national and EU frameworks;
- Facilitate collaboration, knowledge exchange and an interdisciplinary approach to restoration;
- Promote ethical and sustainable actions in relation to biodiversity conservation and restoration;
- Actively participate in the consultation processes related to the Italian National Restoration Plan (NRP).



Activities

- Meetings of thematic working groups on best practices; law and governance; native plant materials; communication and dissemination; and terminology.
- Organizing symposia, webinars and events aimed at promoting the exchange of experiences and knowledge.
- Consultations with public authorities.
- Data collection and analysis (e.g., surveys) on restoration in Italy.
- Dissemination and awareness about ecological restoration.
